



Dear Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in Educators Credit Union's Raphael "Ralph" Barksdale Jr. Memorial Scholarship program. To be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must be members of Educators Credit Union or a dependent of an Educators Credit Union member, and currently enrolled in their final year of high school (senior).

Twelve (12) scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded based on scholastic achievement and community involvement. An unbiased Scholarship Committee, made up of school, community and credit union officials will judge the applicants. Funds will be applied toward tuition for the academic school sessions of Summer or Fall 2021 or Spring 2022.

Follow all directions completely and carefully. Regarding the letters of recommendation, it is imperative that **each be sealed in an envelope bearing the return address of the school for which the person writing the recommendation works.**

Your transcript and both letters of recommendation must be included in the envelope with the completed scholarship application. Incomplete applications will be disqualified.

February 6, 2021 is the final day applications will be accepted. Please bring the application by the credit union on Highway 6 or mail it early to ensure delivery to the credit union before the deadline. The mailing address is: Scholarship, Educators Credit Union, PO Box 20728, Waco, TX 76702-0728. Applications received after this date will be disqualified.

Scholarships will be awarded at the Educators Credit Union Annual Meeting on Monday, March 22, 2021 at 7:00 PM, at the Waco Convention Center. Selected recipients will be notified prior to this day and should plan to attend the meeting.

**EDUCATORS CREDIT UNION'S

Eligibility and Process

1. Applicant must be an Educators Credit Union member or a dependent of a member.
2. Applicant must be currently enrolled in final year of high school (senior).
3. Applicant must provide a copy of his or her most recent high school transcript showing applicant's class rank and SAT and/or ACT and/or TSI score(s).
4. Applicant must include a typed essay describing future aspirations in at least 250 words. Include your interests, goals and planned field of study.
5. Applicant must provide two (2) letters of recommendation from faculty and/or staff at applicant's high school. Letters of recommendation must be written by someone other than relatives of the applicant or members of the Educators Credit Union Scholarship Committee and must be in a **sealed** envelope bearing the return address of the school for which the person writing the recommendation works. (See form in this packet.)
6. Applicant may include, if appropriate, any other family or financial information of which the Scholarship Committee should be aware.
7. Applicants **will not** be accepted under any circumstances after February 6, 2021. If mailing applications, allow ample time for any delays in the mail system. (No exceptions made for delayed arrival of applications through mail system.)
8. All scholarship materials must be returned at the same time and sealed in a large envelope. No partial applications will be accepted.
- 9. Failure to follow all instructions could cause disqualification.**
